Dear Mr. Werbrock:

On June 29, 2020, and October 21, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Pacific Atlantic Action Coalition, Pacific Environmental Coalition, Matt Cohler, Tom van Loben Sels, and Melissa Carrig, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On October 26, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that Pacific Atlantic Action Coalition, Pacific Environmental Coalition, and Matt Cohler violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and to take no action at this time as to Tom Van Loben Sels and Melissa Carrig. The Commission was also equally divided on dismissing the allegations. Accordingly, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
