Dear Messrs. Reiff and Mitrani:

On June 29, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, VoteVets and Rick Hegdahl in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On October 26, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to take no action at this time as to VoteVets and Rick Hegdahl in his official capacity as treasurer. The Commission was also equally divided on dismissing the allegations. Accordingly, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
