Dear Mr. Hurley:

On July 17, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a Complaint indicating violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the Complaint was forwarded to you at that time.

The Commission considered the Complaint, but was equally divided on whether to find no reason to believe or dismiss the allegations that you violated the Act or Commission regulations. Accordingly, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter on June 15, 2022. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
