To whom it may concern,

I have carefully read Christine Wilson's complaint, and I do not believe there are even allegations of violations of the Federal Campaign Act of 1971. I have not violated any statute or regulation, and request that the complaint against me be dismissed and that no action be taken against me.

I did work for the Green Party of New York (GPNY), also named in the complaint, 10 hours per week in 2019 and in doing so committed no violations of the Federal Campaign Act of 1971, neither as an individual, nor as an independent contractor of GPNY.

I informed the Executive Committee of GPNY that on two occasions, April 2019 and again in August of 2019, that I took on independent contractor work for the Howie Hawkins campaign.

I began full-time employment with the Green Party of the United States in September of 2019. I completed my independent contractor work with the Hawkins campaign prior to my hiring. In doing so I committed no violations of the Federal Campaign Act of 1971 nor have I done so during the course of my employment for the Green Party of the United States.
