This is in reference to the Complaint you filed with the Federal Election Commission dated July 28, 2020 and supplemented on August 14, 2020 and February 3, 2021, concerning a possible foreign national contribution from Queensgate Homes Inc. (Vensota Properties), to Florida Country in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (“the Act”). Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, information supplied by respondents, and after considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission, on November 9, 2021, lacking a sufficient number of votes to either dismiss or find reason to believe that Respondents had violated the Act, voted to close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
