On June 30, 2020, following the consideration of a referral from the Audit Division, the Commission found reason to believe that the Ambulatory Surgery Center Association Political Action Committee and John Greenwich in his official capacity as treasurer ("ASCAPAC" or "Respondents") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) by accepting prohibited corporate contributions, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) by failing to properly report receipts, and violated 52 U.S.C.

> The Commission authorized the Office of the General Counsel to settle this matter through pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a proposed conciliation agreement.²
