SUBJECT: MUR 7774 (Antone for Congress, *et al.*)
Revised Proposed Conciliation Agreement

On July 12, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Antone for Congress and Dennis Melton in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(5)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b)(4) by misreporting the payee of funds paid to West Coast Public Affairs and authorized pre-probable cause conciliation.¹ The Commission also approved the Factual and Legal Analyses (“F&LA”) — as recommended in the First General Counsel’s Report dated July 30, 2021, subject to the edits last circulated by Commissioner Cooksey’s Office on Thursday, June 16, 2022 at 8:42 p.m. and further subject to the restoration of the deleted portions discussed at the table
