1. Dismiss with caution the allegation that Jeannine Lake violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(e)(1) by failing to file and timely file Statement of Candidacy.
2. Dismiss with caution the allegation that Lake for Congress Committee and Constance Saylease Prater- Baker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30103(c) by failing to amend Statements of Organization.
3. Dismiss with caution the allegation that Lake for Congress Committee and Constance Saylease Prater-Baker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a) by failing to timely file disclosure reports.
4. Dismiss the allegation that Lake for Congress Committee and Constance Saylease Prater-Baker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(5)(A) and 6(A) by failing to properly itemize disbursements.
5. Dismiss the allegation that Jeannine Lake and Lake for Congress and Constance Saylease Prater-Baker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use.
