1. Dismiss the allegation that the North Carolina Republican Party and Zachary Crofts in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(4) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b) by failing to report a coordinated party expenditure.
2. Dismiss the allegation that the North Carolina Republican Party and Zachary Crofts in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11(d)(2) by distributing party coordinated communications without the appropriate disclaimer.
3. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 18, 2021, subject to the edits last circulated by Commissioner Weintraub's Office on April 25, 2022 at 5:24 p.m.
4. Approve the appropriate letters.
5. Close the file.
