

- a. Find no reason to believe that Fight for the American Dream PAC and Megan Troy in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(a)(1)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(b)(1) by making an excessive in-kind contribution or violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b) by failing to report an in-kind contribution.

- b. Close the file.
- c. Issue appropriate letters.

Commissioners Cooksey and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Broussard, Dickerson, Walther, and Weintraub dissented.

3. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
- a. Find reason to believe that Fight for the American Dream PAC and Megan Troy in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(a)(1)(A) and 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(b)(1) by making an excessive in-kind contribution and violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b) by failing to report an in-kind contribution.
  - b. Direct the Office of General Counsel to appropriately amend the Factual and Legal Analysis and Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 18, 2020, consistent with these findings.
  - c. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Fight for the American Dream PAC and Megan Troy in her official capacity as treasurer.
  - d. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.
