Dear Mr. Spies and Ms. Reynolds:

On August 24, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Friends of Byron Donalds and Noreen Fenner, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On April 26, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe your client violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). One or more Statements of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission's decision, will follow.
