On August 28, 2020 and February 1, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint and supplemental complaint alleging that you had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 10, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find no reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(5)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b) and equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegations pursuant to *Heckler v. Chaney*. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). One or more Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
