Dear Mr. Knight:

On September 22, 2020, the Commission notified your clients, Thom Tillis Committee and Collin McMichael in his official capacity as treasurer and Thom Tillis Victory Committee and Collin McMichael in his official capacity as treasurer, of the MUR 7793 complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint the Commission, on October 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30118 and 30122 by making corporate contributions in the name of another, and closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
