On September 23, and September 24, 2020, the Commission notified you of the MUR 7793 and MUR 7801 complaints, respectively, alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Copies of the complaints were forwarded to you at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaints the Commission, on October 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations that you permitted your name to be used to make contributions in the name of another in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30122, and closed the file in these matters. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
