Dear Mr. Babbitt:

On September 22 and September 24, 2020, the Commission notified your client, XPO Logistics f/k/a New Breed Holding Corp., of the MUR 7793 and MUR 7801 complaints, respectively, alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Copies of the complaints were forwarded to your client at those times.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint the Commission, on October 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations that your client violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30118 and 30122 by making corporate contributions in the name of another, and closed the file in these matters. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.
