On September 28, 2020, the Commission notified your clients, James Arnold, Ron Bistol, Ashfaque Chowdhury, Gene Corbett, Mark Edwards, Bill Fraine, Eric Henningsen, Peter Gagliano, Dennis Hunt, Thomas James, Ron Jarriel, Christina Clymer Jones, Thomas McGoldrick, Michael Mehling, David Robinson, Scott Robinson, John Schneider, Mary Ann D'Antono Uehlein, and Richard Valitutto, of the MUR 7801 complaint, alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint the Commission, on October 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegation that your clients permitted their names to be used to make a contribution in the name of another in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30122, and closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
