On September 28, 2020, the Commission notified you of the MUR 7801 complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to you at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint the Commission, on October 28, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegation that you permitted your name to be used to make a contribution in the name of another in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30122, and closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.
