On October 27, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Theresa Greenfield for Iowa and Theresa Kehoe in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging that your client violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by you, the Commission, on May 26, 2022, voted to dismiss this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
