In response to RE: MUR 7831 the following statement and enclosures are presented.

I did in fact submit the ad referenced in the complaint. In my mind I considered this a classified ad not realizing a disclaimer was required. There was no ill motives or foolery intended, or effort to hide my identity. This was a onetime ad and if I were to place any political ads in the future the disclaimer will be included as required by federal law.

At the request of Mecklenburg County Democratic Committee, I am appointed to the Electoral Board, and serve with the utmost respect in a nonpartisan manner when carrying out the duties of an Electoral Board member.

As stated in the "Virginia Department of Elections the Handbook" Chapter 2 Local Electoral Boards II i

Electoral Board members are not prohibited from exercising their freedom of speech when not performing the Electoral Board duties.<sup>ii</sup> Opinions of the Attorney General ruled electoral board members and general registrars should perform their official duties in a nonpartisan fashion and when not performing those duties, such officers may participate in partisan political activities that do not conflict with the prohibitions set forth in this section and 24.2-106.1 and 24.2-110. See opinion of Attorney General to Mr. William B. Harvey, Secretary, Albemarle County Electoral Board, 03-068 (10/17/03).<sup>iii</sup>

Mr. Rick Buchanan, who filed the complaint against me serves as the Vice Chair of 5<sup>th</sup> District Republican Congressional Committee, which it appears he did not make a full disclosure of his position in the Republican Party.
