Dear Mr. Gheen:

On February 15, 2022, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated October 21, 2020 and found that on the basis of the information provided in the complaint, and information provided in the responses, there is no reason to believe Facebook, Inc., Google LLC, or Twitter Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a). Accordingly, on February 15, 2022, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which more fully explains the Commission's finding is enclosed.

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's decision in this matter. See 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
