On October 28, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Google LLC ("Google"), of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was included in that notification. On March 26, 2021, we received your client's response to the complaint. On February 15, 2022, the Commission found no reason to believe that Google violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
