On November 4, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, America First Action, Inc. and Jon Proch in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, the Commission, on February 14, 2022, voted to dismiss the allegations as to your client.
