On November 4, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Senate Leadership Fund and Caleb Crosby in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, the Commission, on February 14, 2022, voted to dismiss the allegations as to your client.
