Dear Mr. Gagnon:

We represent American Working Families (AWF), a federal independent committee. Last August Excel Dryer, Inc contributed \$10,000 to AWF.

A recent news report was brought to our attention that a complaint was being filed with the Federal Election Commission alleging that Excel Dryer is a federal government contractor. If this is true, we were unaware that Excel Dryer is a federal government contractor.

AWF is prohibited by law from accepting contributions from federal government contractors. Absent of an affirmative statement from Excel Dryer, Inc stating that it is not a federal government contractor, we must assume the opposite is true -- and refund your contribution.

Please find enclosed a refund check for \$10,000, equal to your contribution from last August.
