On October 27, 2020, and December 8, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, the Iowa Democratic Party and Ken Sagar in his official capacity as treasurer, of complaints alleging that your client violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaints, and information supplied by you, the Commission, on May 26, 2022, voted to dismiss this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
