On December 23, 2020, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Salt River Valley Water Users' Association, Salt River Valley Water Users' Association Political Involvement Committee and Heidi Schaefer, in her official capacity as treasurer, and Mike Jones, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the complaint was previously forwarded to your clients.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the respondents, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter on May 12, 2022. One or more Statements of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission's decision, will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
