THIRD CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING


In order to provide for a possible resolution of this matter through pre-probable cause conciliation, Respondents, South Dakota Democratic Party and Marcia Bunger in her official capacity as treasurer, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7872 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a) for a period of thirty (30) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for an additional thirty (30) calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. This Consent supplements the Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding dated February 10, 2021, and the Second Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding dated July 28, 2021.

There shall be no additional extension of the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondents.
