MUR 7874**VERIFIED COMPLAINT****Introduction**

Karyn Kay Griffin hereby files this Complaint against Patriots of America PAC and its Treasurer, Daniel Backer, for violating FEC reporting requirements in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g) and 11. C.F.R. § 104.14(g) and other violations of applicable laws governing campaign finance and political action committees.

Patriots of America PAC and Daniel Backer have made fraudulent representations to the FEC regarding the source and amount of contributions the PAC has reported in violation of FEC law and regulations. The Patriots of America PAC has submitted at least one report that contains falsified financial contribution information. Such contributions received without proper accounting and origin information could interfere with the United States election process. The Commission should take action to protect the general public from the willful campaign finance violations and fraudulent actions of Respondents.

PARTIES

Complainant Karyn Kay Griffin ("Griffin") is the former co-chair of Patriots of America PAC.

Respondent Patriots of America PAC ("POA PAC") is a non-connected hybrid political action committee registered with the FEC.

Respondent Daniel Backer ("Backer") is the Treasurer, legal adviser and Ex-Officio member of the POA PAC and, upon information and belief, the individual responsible for the creation, management, and affairs of the POA PAC.

OTHER PARTIES

Henry ("Hank") Foley is a co-chair of the POA PAC.

Timothy ("Tim") Viens is a co-chair of the POA PAC.

Tim Reed is a director of the POA PAC.

Simone Greear is a director of the POA PAC.

Daniel Friebis is a board member of the POA PAC.

FACTS

On January 1, 2020, Patriots PAC of America (Patriots PAC), not to be confused with respondent Patriots of America PAC, was formed for the proposed purpose of registering voters who supported the Trump presidential campaign and to use NASCAR races to bring attention to that agenda. Backer submitted a statement of organization with the FEC. Backer was listed as treasurer and legal counsel, Hank Foley and William Ray Delarosa were listed as co-chairs, and Timothy Viens was listed as Ex-Officio of the Patriots PAC. The Patriots PAC of America planned to fund a NASCAR racing team with a Trump/Pence 2020-wrapped racing car and truck promoting President Trump's re-election. This required using the Patriots PAC's disclaimer on the truck or car identifying the Patriots PAC as the sponsor of the advertising. Viens intended to race the truck for the Patriots PAC. On January 30, 2020, Viens, Foley, and Delarosa formed Race Fans for Trump, LLC, for the purpose of selling Trump-branded political merchandise. Subsequently, Race Fans for Trump LLC, donated \$27,000 to the Patriots PAC of America. Shortly thereafter, the Patriots PAC reportedly paid \$25,000 to the Mike Harmon Race Team to sponsor car #47, driven by NASCAR driver Joe Nemechek, in a race in Daytona, Florida on February 14, 2020, which raced with the Patriots PAC Trump advertising. Also, on February 14, 2020, another \$25,000 was recorded as an in-kind carry contribution from Viens to the Patriots PAC.

The Patriots PAC Board voted to dissolve the PAC on February the 18th, 2020. The same day the Race Fans for Trump, LLC was also dissolved. Its only documented business activities were the contributions to the Patriot PAC. That same day, Backer formed Patriots of America PAC with the FEC and listed himself as the treasurer and legal counsel. Foley and Viens were listed as co-chairs.

In late February 2020, Griffin was introduced to Viens and Foley through mutual acquaintances. At that time, the POA PAC had limited funds, and Griffin was brought in to raise funds. At that time, she was not made aware of the previous Patriots PAC of America. She met with a potential donor in June 2020 who agreed to provide over one million dollars for the POA PAC to pursue the same goal as its predecessor Patriots PAC, which was to race cars with Trump 2020 advertising. Griffin provided almost all of the funding received by the POA PAC. As a condition of the donor providing these funds, Griffin was to be appointed co-chair of the POA PAC, replacing Viens. Under the POA PAC bylaws, as co-chair, Griffin had to approve all expenses and all FEC reports before they were filed.

Griffin recruited Tim Reid and Simone Greear, who were knowledgeable about NASCAR events, to serve on the POA PAC's board of directors. Griffin, Reid, and Greear were all unaware that prior to officially taking positions on the board of directors, Foley restructured the board to include his ex-father-in-law, Dan Friebe. Backer was later added as Ex Officio board member. This was a strategic move to give Foley, Viens and Backer complete control of the funds by having a majority of four votes under their control.

At the time he served on the POA PAC, Viens was subject to substantial legal judgments against him, and the plaintiffs in certain of those matters were attempting to attach his assets. On information and belief, Viens has attempted to hide his assets. Griffin, Reid, and Greear expressed concern to Backer about Viens's association with the POA PAC and the possibility that creditors might seek to attach the POA PAC's assets. However, Backer assured them that creditors could not attach the assets of the PAC.

Viens apparent attempt to conceal assets became an issue for the POA PAC after a NASCAR event in Atlanta on June 6, 2020. Viens apparently decided to use his \$25,000 credit

from the Patriots PAC to race a truck with the Trump advertising, while a car driven by Joe Nemecek of the Harmon Racing Team also would race with the Trump advertising. However, Viens' truck failed inspection, and he was not allowed to race. However, the Nemecek car did race with the Trump advertising, and had the color scheme of the defunct Patriots PAC, but with the disclaimer for the POA PAC.

Neither Griffin, Reed, nor Greear knew before the race that a car presumably associated with their POA PAC was going to be raced. When Reed stated that he had heard a car had raced at Atlanta with the Trump 2020 advertising, Foley and Viens initially denied knowing anything about the race. When Ms. Griffin asked Becker about this, he also said he was unaware of the race or any Trump advertising associated with the POA PAC.

Eventually Viens admitted that he knew that the Nemecek car with Trump advertising had run on June 6. When Reed asked who had paid for the race because he was concerned that the POA PAC money had been used, Viens stated he had used his credit to pay for the race and advertising. Apparently, this credit related to the credit Viens had received for a contribution to the Patriots PAC in February

Nevertheless, despite Viens' claim to have paid with his deposit for the car to race, Backer told Griffin that he intended to report to the FEC that Mike Harmon's Racing Team had made an "in-kind" donation to the PAC of \$9,500 for racing the car with the Trump advertising. Griffin asked Backer for the basis for doing this and for recognizing it as a \$9,500 donation because she knew racing teams typically charged substantially more for advertising. For example, as discussed above, a similar race in February had cost \$25,000. When Griffin asked for proof relating to the contribution, Backer initially told her that none existed. However, later, Backer produced a form allegedly signed by Mike Harmon stating that racing team had made an

in-kind contribution for "Trump/Pence 2020 marketing" at the Atlanta race and valued the contribution as \$9,500. *See Exhibit 1.* Backer told Griffin that this contribution needed to be recorded because otherwise the POA PAC could be investigated for accepting an "unreported independent expenditure." He also told her that by listing the amount as being under \$10,000, the PAC would be in compliance with quarterly reporting requirements because if the contribution was over \$10,000 it triggered more immediate reporting requirements.

Griffin doubted the validity of the form and Backer's convoluted explanation. She subsequently obtained another document with Harmon's actual signature on it. *See Exhibit 2.* As is plainly obvious, the signatures do not match. Griffin later contacted a member of the Harmon Racing Team very familiar with Harmon's signature. He confirmed that the signature on Exhibit 1 produce to her by Backer is not Harmon's.

Griffin refused to authorize the filing of the quarterly report that included the false in-kind contribution. She recommended that Viens report this as his contribution. Backer refused to do this and then obtained instructions from the POA PAC co-chair, Foley, to file the report with the Harmon \$9500 in-kind contribution, which Backer did. *See Exhibit 3.* Two days later, Backer arbitrarily acted to remove Griffin from the POA PAC and reinstalled Viens as the co-chair.

On information and belief, the false Harmon contribution was created to conceal the fact that Tim Viens had used his \$25,000 credit to pay for the advertising for the June 6 race. On information and belief, Harmon has no knowledge that Backer listed his racing team as having made an in-kind contribution on the FEC report, and he and his racing team did not make such an in-kind contribution to the POA PAC.

CAUSE OF ACTION

COUNT I (AGAINST ALL RESPONDENTS)

Complainant hereby re-alleges and incorporates by reference the preceding paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

Under 52 U.S.C. § 30104 and 11. C.F.R. § 104.14 PAC's must file accurate and honest reports. The filing of false reports is a violation of FEC regulations and statutes. Despite these requirements, Backer knowingly filed on behalf of the POA PAC a report that falsely reported a \$9,500 in-kind contribution from the Mike Harmon racing team that was never made.

WHEREFORE, Respondents violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104 and 11. C.F.R. § 104.14.

CONCLUSION

For these reasons, Complainant Griffin respectfully requests the FEC commence enforcement proceedings against Respondents.

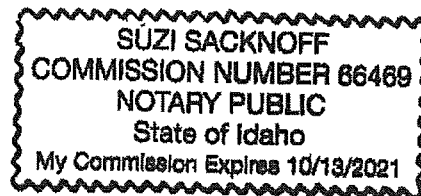


