 - b. Find no reason to believe that Timothy Viens or Henry "Hank" Foley in his personal capacity violated the Act or Commission regulations in connection with this matter.
 - c. Direct the Office of General Counsel to draft separate Factual and Legal Analyses with Dan Backer in his personal capacity, and Patriots of America PAC and Henry "Hank" Foley in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - d. Direct the Office of General Counsel to draft separate Conciliation Agreements with Dan Backer in his personal capacity, and Patriots of America and Henry "Hank" Foley in his official capacity as treasurer.
