I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on June 23, 2022, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

## 1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

- a. Find reason to believe that NRA Victory Fund, Inc., and Christina M. Majors in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)(4) by failing to report employer and occupation information for individual contributors.
- b. Direct the Office of General Counsel to transfer the matter to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office.
- c. Send the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

## 2. Failed by a vote of 2-4 to:

- a. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegations that NRA Victory Fund, Inc., and Christina M. Majors in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)(4) by failing to report employer and occupation

- c. Approve the appropriate letters.
- d. Close the file.

Commissioners Cooksey and Dickerson voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Close the file.
- b. Issue appropriate letters.
