Dear Mr. Spies:

On February 22, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, NRA Victory Fund, Inc., and Robert Owens in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 22, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that NRA Victory Fund, Inc., and Christina M. Majors in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)(4) by failing to report employer and occupation information for individual contributors. The Commission was also equally divided on dismissing the allegations. Accordingly, on June 23, 2022, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision is not required in this matter, but if one is issued, it will be provided to you.
