I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on July 26, 2022, do hereby certify that the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in MURs 7883 and 7884:

1. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that the American Firearms Association violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c), (g) and 11 C.F.R. § 109.10(b), (d) by failing to properly report independent expenditures.
2. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that the American Firearms Association violated 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a)(3) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11 by failing to include a required disclaimer.
3. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that Georgia Gun Owners, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c) and 11 C.F.R. § 109.10(b) by failing to properly report independent expenditures.
4. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that Georgia Gun Owners, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a)(3) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11 by failing to include a required disclaimer.
5. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated June 30, 2022, subject to the edits circulated by the Offices of Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub on July 25, 2022 at 1:20 p.m.
6. Approve the appropriate letters.
