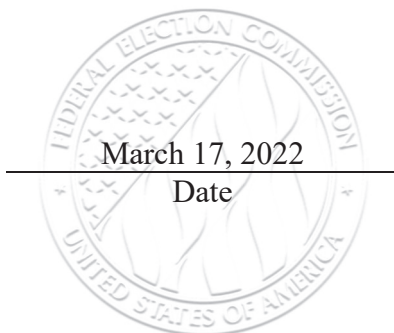
CERTIFICATION

1. Accept the signed conciliation agreement Hamilton Company, as recommended in the Memorandum to the Commission dated March 1, 2022.
2. Dismiss the allegation that Americans for Prosperity Action and Robert Jentgens in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(2) by knowingly soliciting federal contractor contributions.
