Dear Messrs. Josefiak & Bayes:

On March 24, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Senate Leadership fund and Caleb Crosby in his official capacity as treasurer (“Senate Leadership Fund”), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On January 11, 2022, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by respondents, that there is no reason to believe Senate Leadership Fund violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(2) by knowingly soliciting a prohibited federal contractor contribution. The Commission has now closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702. A Statement of Reasons further explaining the basis for the Commission's decision may follow.
