
Re: Second Extension for Response to MUR

Dear Ms. Ross,

This Firm represents True the Vote, Inc. and its President, Catherine Engelbrecht (collectively, "Respondent") in the Matter Under Review 7894. On April 9, 2021, Respondent received notification of the Complaint that is the subject of the MUR. Pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(1), Respondent to MUR 7894 has the opportunity to demonstrate in writing within fifteen (15) days of notification that the Commission should take no further action.

On April 23, 2021, Respondent sought and received a thirty day extension, making their response due on May 26, 2021.
