## **ORDER**

**ORDERED** that the plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, Dkt. 13, is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**. It is further

**ORDERED** that the defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment, Dkt. 14, is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**. Accordingly, it is further

**DECLARED** that the defendant's failure to find reason to believe that the Georgia Republican Party, Inc. failed to report its receipts and disbursements to the Commission was contrary to law. It is further

**ORDERED** that the Commission shall conform with such declaration within 30 days. It is further

**ORDERED** that the plaintiff's action is otherwise dismissed without prejudice.
