Dear Mr. Jordan:

We write as counsel to DNC Services Corp./Dem. Nat'l Committee (the "Committee") and William Q. Derrough in his official capacity as Treasurer of the Committee (collectively, "the Respondents") regarding the above-referenced referral, RR 19L-14. The Committee received notice of the referral on July 15, 2019, and therefore a response is due on July 30, 2019. However, the Respondents respectfully request that the response time be extended for 60 days.

This extension is warranted for several reasons. First, responding to this referral will involve reviewing and analyzing voluminous records from several years ago, requiring many hours to staff time. Second, several of the transactions covered by the amendment occurred prior to current staff's tenure and will therefore take additional time to research. Third, both Committee staff and counsel have business and personal travel scheduled during the next several weeks, complicating the Committee's ability to coordinate the necessary review of the relevant materials. This travel includes travel for the second Democratic Presidential Primary Debate at the end of July. As such, extending the Committee's response deadline by 60 days will afford the Committee the time it needs to collect relevant documents and facts and review them so as to adequately respond to this referral.
