1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

 - b. Find reason to believe that DNC Services Corp./Dem. Nat'l Committee and William Q. Derrough in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.3(d), 104.11(a), and 104.11(b) by failing to disclose debt on its 2017 Year-End Report.
 - c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated March 25, 2020.
 - d. Authorize pre-probable cause conciliation with DNC Services Corp./Dem. Nat'l Committee and William Q. Derrough in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - e. Approve the proposed conciliation agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated March 25, 2020, subject to the revised civil penalty circulated by the Office of General Counsel on Wednesday, March 3, 2021 at 8:28 a.m.

- f. Approve the appropriate letters.
