25 On March 9, 2021, the Commission approved a conciliation offer to Integrity NJ and  
26 Kathleen Donohue in her official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") to settle violations of  
27 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(1) and (2) by failing to file a 24-hour and 48-hour notice of independent  
28 expenditures.<sup>1</sup>
