**TWELFTH CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission’s agreement to extend the period of time for pre-probable cause to believe conciliation negotiations in this matter, Respondent, Virgin Islands Republican Party and John Canegata, in his official capacity as treasurer, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations an twelfth time for any civil enforcement suit that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MURs 7546 and 7898 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of thirty (30) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit, for an additional thirty (30) days, any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
