NINETEENTH CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to extend the period of time for pre-probable cause to believe conciliation negotiations in this matter, Respondent, Virgin Islands Republican Party and John Canegata in his official capacity as treasurer, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MURs 7546 and 7898 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of thirty (30) days.

This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of thirty (30) days from the expiration date of the Consent to Extend Time to Institute a Civil Law Enforcement Action signed by Respondent on October 18, 2022, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
