I, Laura E. Sinram, Acting Secretary and Clerk of the Federal Election Commission, do hereby certify that on April 15, 2021, the Commission decided by a vote of 5-0 to take the following actions in RAD Referral 18L-32:

1. Open a Matter Under Review. **MUR 7900**
2. Find reason to believe that Mensah Real Estate Property, LLC, and Stephen Cannon knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(b)(3) by commingling Committee funds with their own.
3. Take no action at this time as to allegations that Black Americans for a Better Future and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(c) and 30104(b) by failing to keep complete records and file accurate reports.
4. Approve the factual and legal analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated October 3, 2019.
5. Approve the use of compulsory process.
6. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Dickerson, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioner Cooksey abstained.
