On May 25, 2021, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Mensah Real Estate Property, LLC knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(b)(3) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (the “Act”) by commingling Committee funds with its own funds. There was no response submitted to the Commission’s reason to believe finding. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 23, 2022, to take no further action as to Mensah Real Estate Property, LLC and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
