Dear Mr. Cannon:

On July 28, 2021, this Office attempted to notify Stephen Cannon by United Parcel service mail that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Stephen Cannon knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(b)(3) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (the "Act") by commingling Committee funds with his own funds. The delivery of the reason-to-believe notification letter was returned as undeliverable. There was no response submitted by you to the Commission's reason-to-believe finding. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 23, 2022, to take no further action as to Stephen Cannon and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
