CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on July 28, 2022, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 0-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that the Sixteen Thirty Fund and The Hub Project violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104 by not registering as a political committee and meeting the Act's organizational, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements.
 - b. Find reason to believe that the New Venture Fund and the Hub Education and Engagement Fund violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104 by not registering as a political committee and meeting the Act's organizational, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements.
 - c. Find reason to believe that the Wyss Foundation and the Berger Action Fund violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104 by not registering as a political committee and meeting the Act's organizational, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub dissented. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor abstained.

2. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Dismiss the allegations that the Sixteen Thirty Fund and The Hub Project violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.
- b. Dismiss the allegations that the New Venture Fund and the Hub Education and Engagement Fund violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.
- c. Dismiss the allegations that the Wyss Foundation and the Berger Action Fund violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.

3. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Find no reason to believe that Hansjörg Wyss, the Wyss Foundation, the Berger Action Fund, Inc., the New Venture Fund, and the Sixteen Thirty Fund made foreign national contributions and contributions in the name of another.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub dissented.

4. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Close the file.
- b. Issue the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
