On July 27, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Taurus Holdings, Inc., of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On September 13, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to dismiss or find no reason to believe as to the allegation that your client violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(1)(A) by making prohibited foreign national contributions, expenditures, independent expenditures, or disbursements for electioneering communications. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
