


**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an additional extension of time for Respondents to submit an additional response to the notification of RR 19L-09, Respondents Rebuilding America Now and Chris Marston in his official capacity as treasurer hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with RR 19L-09 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for an additional period of ninety (90) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for an additional period of 90 calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondents.
