  - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 25, 2022, and subject to the edits as last circulated by Commissioner Cooksey's Office on Tuesday, May 24, 2022 at 4:36 p.m.
  - e. Approve the appropriate letters.
  - f. Close the file.
