Dear Mr. Holmes:

On May 26, 2022, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated August 4, 2021 and found that on the basis of the information provided in the complaint, and information provided in the responses, there is no reason to believe Oklahomans for T.R.U.M.P. PAC, Citizens for a Great Broken Arrow, and Init2 LLC violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). Accordingly, on May 26, 2022, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission’s decision in this matter. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
