On August 10, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was included in that notification. On August 11, 2021, we received your response to the complaint. On May 26, 2022, the Commission found no reason to believe that a violation of the Act occurred. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
